

ORDINANCE #1982-1

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF  
THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE BY FAYAL TOWNSHIP AND ITS CITIZENS

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Fayal  
ordains, as follows:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person within the limits  
of the Township of Fayal to store or place any garbage on a public  
street or within twenty (20) feet from the outer boundaries of the  
street in question unless said garbage is contained in a concealed  
container.

SECTION 2.

It is hereby made unlawful to use a concealed container  
that is not constructed of either metal or hard plastic materials  
and that said container must have a tight forming lid or cover.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby made unlawful to use a container that is  
not impervious to any animals.

SECTION 4.

Any person violating the terms or provisions of this  
ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined a sum not to  
exceed \$500.00 or shall be imprisoned not to exceed ninety (90)  
days.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from  
and after its passage, approval and publication.
