FAYAL TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING

MARCH 13, 2012

The Town of Fayal Annual Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Clerk Judy Sersha. According to the sign-in sheet, 30 persons were in attendance. A list of those attending is attached to these minutes.

Clerk Sersha welcomed everyone to the Annual Meeting and stated the first order of business is to stand and say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Sersha then called for nominations for moderator.

Motion by Lee Branville, support from Tony Tamaro to nominate Steve Shykes as moderator. Clerk Sersha asked if there were any more nominations, there being none, Sersha called for the question. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Shykes welcomed the people to the Annual Meeting and explained the order of business.

APPROVAL OF THE 2011 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 8, 2011 Annual Meeting, made by Scott Smith, support from John Damberg. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL AND TREASURER'S REPORT

Moderator Shykes then called upon Clerk/Treasurer Judy Sersha to report on the financial status of the town. The General fund began the year with \$731,498 and ended the year with a \$604,264.00 balance. The Road & Bridge Special Revenue fund began the year with \$282,416 and ended the year with a \$282,419 balance. The Town of Fayal Net Assets total as of December 31, 2011 was \$13,305,177.00. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Motion to approve the 2011 Financial & Treasurer's Report, made by Ed Vest, support from Ron Erjavec. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL NEEDS FOR THE TOWN

Steve Kniefel, Town Board Chair, welcomed everyone and thanked Steve Shykes for agreeing to serve as moderator again this year. Mr. Kniefel thanked and recognized the town board members, clerk and employees for all the work they do for the township.

Mr. Kniefel then explained the 2013 board recommended levy to the audience. Mr. Kniefel explained the levy was reduced by the townspeople in 2011 and 2012 and for 2013 the board is recommending an increase of 8.44 percent because the town has had to use reserves, and those reserves have now been reduced. The proposed recommendations for 2013- General- \$90,000.00, Fire- \$62,000.00, Recreation- \$0.00, Police- \$36,000.00, Capital Equipment- \$30,000.00, Buildings & Grounds- \$45,000.00, Road & Bridge- \$263,800, for a total of \$526,800.00, or a 8.44% increase over 2012.

DESIGNATING POSTING PLACES

Moderator Shykes explained the present location of our posting places are as follows: 1) Fayal Town Hall, 2) West Long Lake Road, 3) East Long Lake Road, 4) Ely Lake Shortstop, 5) At Your Convenience, 6) Differding Point, 7) Fayal Website.

Motion to keep the posting places the same made by Joe Petrich, support from Scott Smith. Motion carried unanimously.

SETTING TOWN BOARD SALARIES

Moderator Shykes then stated the next order of business is setting compensation for town board members. As of January 1, 2012 the Conus rate for mileage is 55.5 cents per mile. Currently, the salaries are as follows: Supervisor- \$3,828 per year, or \$319 per month, plus mileage and expenses as incurred, and Chair- \$4,224 per year, or \$352 per month, plus mileage and expenses.

Motion by John Damberg, support from Mike Priest to keep the salaries the same. Motion carried unanimously.

FIRE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS

Fire Chief Steve Shykes reported there were a total of 128 calls in 2011, of which 55 were EMS. Presently there are 22 firefighters on the department and 3 openings. The fire department had 720 hours of in-house training and 240 hours of outside training. There are two Mesabi Community College fire instructors on the department. The agreement between the Fayal Fire Department and the Eveleth Fire Department is working out very well. The department held its 25th Anniversary in 2011 with an open house that was very well attended. Chief Shykes reminded everyone to check their homeowners insurance to be sure the Fayal Fire Department is listed as covering their property because our fire department has a better fire rating than other departments, and this can mean savings on your policy. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

SUPERVISORS REPORTS

Road & Bridge- Tony Tammaro had to leave the meeting, but Lee Branville gave his report. Mr. Branville reported that crack sealing and leveling was performed on portions of the town parking lot, Thunderbird Trail and Golf Course Road. Road cuts were filled on Pine Drive and Golf Course Road, and Woodlawn Boulevard East, Woodlawn Circle and a portion of Long Lake Road West were resurfaced. Mr. Branville also reported on planned projects for 2012. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Mr. Branville also reported that Mr. Tamaro has been working on a solar project for the town hall. The township received a \$100,000 IRRRB grant for solar panels to provide the town complex with electricity. Hometown Electric was the contractor selected to install them and the panels are being purchased from Silicon Energy in Mt. Iron. The panels will be placed in the back of the complex near the fire department and the project should be operational by fall.

Planning Committee- Lee Branville reported the committee has been inactive lately. Their major project this past year was the new sign on the corner of Ely Lake Drive and Hwy. 132. The sign points out the location of the town hall complex, is lit, and has a message board on the bottom for announcements. Mr. Branville thanked John Damberg for spearheading the project.

Buildings & Grounds- Jim Pernu was unable to attend tonight's meeting, so Lee Branville gave his report. Mr. Branville reported the skating shack and boards were painted. The tennis court is in good shape, and the playground was filled with new wood chips. A 40 x 40 basketball court was installed last summer, and there is now air conditioning in the town hall. Mr. Branville commented that Mr. Pernu does a top notch job of taking care of the town hall and has done many improvements over the years he has been supervisor. Mr. Branville commended Mr. Pernu for all his hard work. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Police- Steve Kniefel stated that for the past year it has been his pleasure to be the town board liaison to the police and fire departments. Mr. Kniefel commended Steve Shykes for his work as fire chief. Harvey Thompson is the police chief and all of his past years activity is in his report, which has been distributed to the audience. A complete copy of the report is attached to these minutes. Mr. Kniefel stated there has been a lot of discussion over the past two years on whether or not the township should continue to have a police department. The issue has been resolved by the town board placing it on the ballot this November for the townspeople to vote on. Until a decision is made by the people, we will continue with the police department as we have in the past.

Bob Mavec asked if Harvey Thompson is elected as a supervisor in Biwabik Township if he can continue as a police officer in Fayal? Mr. Kniefel stated there is absolutely no conflict if Mr. Thompson is elected in another township, he may remain as an employee of Fayal.

Public Utilities- Mike Erjavec reported there has been lots of cooperation between Eveleth and Fayal this past year, but just the opposite between Gilbert and Fayal. Eveleth raised their residents water rates 10% and also raised the rates to Fayal by the same amount. We passed this on to our customers. We recently signed a five year water contract with Eveleth, through 2018. Eveleth is looking at replacing their waterline to the airport and also extending to their gravel pit, so water may be available to more St. Mary's Lake residents. Gilbert raised their sewer rate to us by about 60 percent. We protested this increase, and they sued us. The judge ruled in Gilbert's favor, and we now owe them \$114,000. We are looking at our options, but the sewer rate will be increased in the near future. There is also an opening on the Public Utilities Commission. A complete copy of the report is attached to these minutes.

David Hamalainen asked if the five year contract with Eveleth includes any rate increases? Mr. Erjavec explained that if Eveleth raises their rates to their customers, we will get the same increase.

Ron Erjavec asked what the recent sewer rate increase was? Mike Erjavec explained the increase that just showed up on the bills in March was for \$2, and the monthly bill is now \$42 per month.

Ralph Johnson asked how much more the sewer is going to increase? Mike Erjavec answered he did not know, Walker Giroux & Hahne will be doing a rate study and making a recommendation.

Mike Priest asked if he could go back to his old system? Mike Erjavec told Mr. Priest if he moved more than 300 feet from the system, he could put in a septic system.

There being no further questions of the town board members, Moderator Shykes stated the next order of business is Other Business.

OTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE MEETING

Motion to set the Annual Meeting of 2013 on the second Tuesday in March at 7:00 PM, made by Ed Vest, support from Ron Erjavec. Motion carried unanimously.

Keith Nelson stated he had two things to bring forward as Commissioner of this district. Mr. Nelson stated a decision has been made to resurface south Ely Lake Drive in 2013. It was a financial decision, and it would be great if we had the money to do enhancements to the road, but we would have to wait until 2018 or 2019 to have those dollars. Mr. Nelson stated he was informed today the county engineers made the decision to move forward with a reclaim overlay, with some drainage issues addressed. Also, this year, Cedar Island Drive is going to be resurfaced, summer 2012. That will be a reclaim overlay. So, both the north and south edges of Ely Lake will be addressed within the next year and a half.

Ralph Johnson stated there is a lot of speeding going on, and he travels Ely Lake Drive a lot. If the road is re-surfaced, there will be more.

Someone asked if there will be rumble strips on the roads? Mr. Nelson stated there will be no rumble strips, but they have been proven to be very effective. There are some issues when they are placed in residential areas, so they will not be a part of either of these roads.

Moderator Shykes stated that if the election in November eliminates local law enforcement, that will mean less patrolling of those areas, so there are things to consider.

Bob Mavec asked Mr. Nelson if they were going to be addressing the intersection of Ely Lake Drive and Shady Lane. Mr. Nelson stated they will be holding meetings out here prior to that— and part of that drainage issue was addressed temporarily. They will be addressing some of the drainage issues along here, lateral pipes etc, and will try to do as much as they can on the drainage issues, within the budget that is available.

Bob Mavec addressed the area in front of Pernu's house on Birch Lane, stating there is a divot right in the roadway. Moderator Shykes stated that is a township road issue, and should be brought to the road and bridge supervisor. Mr. Mavec stated he did.

Ed Vest stated we have been promised for the past couple of years, some new gravel on St. Mary's Court, and nothing has happened so far. The stuff that was put on there a few years ago is sticky and goopy, and is not an adequate surface for anybody to be driving on, because you carry it every place you go. Mr. Vest stated it is time we get something done with it, and stated he would love to see it overlaid, but stated he doubts that will happen.

Moderator Shykes stated the issue will be addressed with the road and bridge supervisor.

Mr. Vest stated they talked about doing some ditching, but it needs to be planned because there gas lines to be moved and you would need to get those in order to get something in motion, because it will take months—if we are going to do something, we need to plan for it, and get it done.

Joe Petrich referred to an article in the paper about the assessors and St. Louis County— stating not in our township, but in other townships where the assessors did not file on new homes, businesses, etc. Mr. Petrich asked Mr. Nelson if they can go back and levy taxes on those new properties from years back? Mr. Ed Vest stated they addressed that issue in the paper, and they can't go back and put a value on it at this point—its almost impossible to do, you could do some type of general thing.

Mr. Nelson stated he would briefly address the issue— assessment is a township issue, and is an issue in every township. The Blue Ribbon Panel, that recently completed their work, did include the former Fayal assessor, as the chair of that panel, Dawn Cole. Mr. Nelson stated Ms. Cole was his appointee to that board because he valued the service she gave to Fayal Township over the years. The Fayal Town Board has elected to go with the county assessor for the past several years. The assessment issues we have county wide are not just township issues. Those assessment issues that have not been addressed in the paper include industrial properties in the City of Duluth that are roughly 15 years behind in assessments. They also include residential properties in the City of Duluth and Hermantown that are 10 years behind. The state mandates a five year cycle on that. The St. Louis County Board has yet to hear a full report on that—we will hear that next Tuesday, and will try to get some official communication out to folks, even if its on the county website to make sure its fair and equitable.

Mr. Steve Kniefel stated since it did not come up in any of the supervisor's reports he would like to inform everyone on the project at the ballfield. Mr. Kniefel stated the township owes a lot of gratitude to Mr. Mark Forte and others who have spearheaded an effort to make improvements to the ballfield located off of Woodlawn. Through Mr. Forte's efforts, we were successful in obtaining a Twin's grant for \$10,000 for upgrades. The township will be matching that amount. In addition, there was a private donation from Justin and Krista Morneau for \$10,000. There has also been a lot of in-house work down there with Al and Steve making grade corrections and spreading agri-lime.

SETTING OF THE 2013 LEVY

Moderator Shykes stated the board recommendation for the 2013 levy is \$526,800, with \$263,800 of that going for Road & Bridge.

Motion by Scott Smith, support from Ed Vest to set the Year 2013 levy at \$526,800.00. Moderator Shykes asked if there was any discussion. Joe Petrich stated he noticed Police went from nothing in 2011 and 2012 to \$36,000, it was \$36,000 in 2010. Moderator Shykes explained that last year's annual meeting a majority group decided not to fund the police, but the service was not eliminated so it was funded out of the general fund. It is on the ballot in November. Instead of taking more unallocated general fund money, the board opted to fund it for the year because the expense will be there, so that department is funded until the election is done. Dave Hamalainen stated the general fund is \$90,000 and if you take \$36,000 of that to fund the police, how much over funded is the general fund? Moderator Shykes asked Judy Sersha to explain. Clerk Sersha stated the general fund is not only \$90,000— we only levy \$90,000. Clerk Sersha stated that earlier in her report, it was stated administration was \$180,000, we only levy about half of what we need to run the general fund.

The rest of the funding comes from taconite production and other fund sources, this offsets the total levy amount. If we did not receive those other funds, we would have to levy for the entire amount. Mr. Ed Vest asked about the homestead credit and what impact that has on the township. Clerk Sersha stated she did not know. Mr. Steve Kniefel stated it will impact you personally more than it will affect the township– you at the annual meeting set the levy, the levy is not going to change– what happens is, part of that is paid by the state as a relief to you as a homeowner. The township portion will stay the same, but you will be paying it out of your pocket, rather than state subsidies paying it. It really does not affect the operation of the township, it affects you- the guy that has to write the check. Joe Sopp asked what the increase was for in Road & Bridge. Clerk Sersha stated the increase is for increased fuel costs and also to put some money away each year for equipment and road improvements. Moderator Shykes stated that levy has been flat for four years and whenever you don't have an increase, eventually you pay for it down the road.

Ralph Johnson questioned what the capital equipment is for- \$30,000 per year? Moderator Shykes stated it is for replacing capital equipment like graders, backhoes, trucks, fire apparatus– instead of paying for it all in one year, we fund it on an ongoing basis so we can use that fund to pay down part of the purchase price. Clerk Sersha stated we have not had to finance anything for many, many years. Moderator Shykes stated we used to have individual capital equipment funds for all the departments, but now it is all lumped into one. Moderator Shykes asked if there was any other discussion on the levy, and John Damberg called for the question. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Joe Sopp, support from Bob Mavec. Motion carried unanimously.

Annual Meeting 2012 adjourned at 8:00 PM.

- 3. There are 8 EMS first responders on the fire department.**
- 4. The new radio system for St. Louis County will be operational in 2012. The fire department received a \$87,000 grant for the radios needed for the new system.**
- 5. In 2011the fire department had 720 hours of in house training and 240 hours of outside training. The fire department has 2 Mesabi Community College fire instructors on the department.**
- 6. The agreement between The Fayal Fire Department and The Eveleth Fire Department for a simulcast page system is working very well.**

2011 ROAD AND BRIDGE REPORT

In 2011, crack routing and sealing and leveling was performed on portions of the parking lot, Thunderbird Trail and Golf Course Road. Road cuts were filled in on Pine Drive and Golf Course Road. Woodlawn Boulevard East, Woodlawn Circle and a portion of Long Lake Road West were resurfaced. About 1,500 yards of class 5 was hauled to and spread out or used as shouldering on various town roads. A 1992 6 yard truck was replaced with a 2012 model.

As much as possible Steve and Al perform in house the required maintenance and repair on township equipment. Other duties include snow plowing and sanding, graveling and grading dirt roads, ditch cleaning, tree trimming and removal in the road right of way, dust control, sign repair and replacement, inspections of various types, culvert replacement and steaming, shouldering and patching blacktop roads, road side mowing and brushing, noxious weed control, operating and maintaining a yard waste sight, sweeping roads and intersections, building or reconstructing segments of roadway. Building and Grounds, Recreation and Public Utilities are other departments that they work for.

They also carry the pager, perform utility locates and fill in for the water/waste water operator. They oversee and work with vendors and contractors on some projects and assist with planning and budgeting for future projects.

Projects that may take place in 2012 are: a 1,400 foot stretch of Golf Course Road might be overlaid or reconstructed, a cost estimate has not yet been obtained. Tree trimming and brush cutting along township right of ways. Class 5 will be applied to various gravel roads. After shouldering Scout Camp Road, quotes may be obtained for striping the center and fog lines. A 1987 John Deere backhoe maybe replaced. Regulatory and warning signs will be replaced to meet the new federal retroreflectivity standards.

2012 Annual Meeting Buildings & Grounds Report
Jim Pernu, March 13, 2012

This past fall we had the Fayal Township hall parking lot cracked sealed. This was near overdue and needed to be done to prevent further cracking and break up of asphalt.

The skating shack and boards were painted last summer and overall should be in good shape. It will be gone over again this summer and any repairs or painting will be again done at this time.

The tennis court which sees a lot of activity should be in relatively good shape. This was crack sealed in 2010 and will be inspected again this spring.

This past fall the playground was filled with wood chips. This is done when needed but usually the chips will last around two years. The playground which really sees a lot of activity is weekly inspected by Al Jurenic to insure it is safe and meets compliance standards. He also attends playground maintenance seminars when available in the area.

In the past we have had numerous complaints of the town hall being too warm or hot during summer events. This past August we invested in air conditioning for the town hall which is now available when the warm weather sets in.

The fire hall has really been maintenance free this past year. I believe we had to change one 4" valve which is used to fill the water wagon. The only real complaint we get from the fire department is that more storage room is needed. This problem is being worked on presently.

This past summer, a basketball court was put in between the hockey rink and our storage building. It is 40' x 40', with a blacktop surface. This also has become a popular place for those interested in basketball.

This next August we will have the tiles in the hall professionally cleaned then all the grout sealed. During this time we will again inspect the tiles for more cracks, as we have found in the past. Our hope is we can get more life out of this floor and not have to replace it anytime soon.

The past year has been a year with lots of cooperation between Eveleth and Fayal as far as our Public Utilities, and just the opposite between Gilbert and Fayal.

Eveleth raised their residents water rates around 10% and also raised the rates to Fayal the same amount, which we passed on to our customers. We asked for, and received, a five year contract extension, and are locked in with Eveleth through 2018.

Eveleth is looking at replacing their water line to the airport and a possible extension to their gravel pit at Thunderbird Trail and Highway 53 for a housing development. This could make water available to some St. Mary's Lake residents.

As far as our sewer, we hadn't raised rates for about three years, and had to raise them about 5%. Gilbert tried to raise their rates to us about sixty percent, and we protested the increase. They ended up suing us. After we made our arguments in court against the increase, the judge ruled in Gilberts favor, saying we owe them \$114,000. We are currently weighing our options, but expect another sewer increase in the near future.

On a more positive side, we have been in discussions with Eveleth in regards to sending our sewage to their plant for treatment. It appears they can maybe handle our sewage and if we can work out a long term contract where we can save money for our customers, we will definitely be pursuing it.
