FAYAL TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING

MARCH 11, 2014, 7:00 PM

The Town of Fayal Annual Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Clerk Judy Sersha. According to the sign-in sheet, 21 persons were in attendance. A list of those attending is attached to these minutes.

Clerk Sersha welcomed everyone to the Annual Meeting and stated the first order of business is to stand and say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Clerk Sersha then called for nominations for moderator.

Motion by Lee Branville, support from Ed Vest to nominate Steve Shykes as moderator. Clerk Sersha asked if there were any more nominations, there being none, Sersha called for the question. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Shykes welcomed the people to the Annual Meeting and explained the order of business.

APPROVAL OF THE 2013 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2013 Annual Meeting, made by Scott Smith, support from Lee Branville. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL AND TREASURER'S REPORT

Moderator Shykes then called upon Clerk/Treasurer Judy Sersha to report on the financial status of the town. The General fund began the year with \$438,141 and ended the year with a \$398,461.00 balance. The Road & Bridge Special Revenue fund began the year with \$303,191 and ended the year with a \$246,320 balance. The Town of Fayal Net Assets total as of December 31, 2013 was \$12,965,263.00. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Motion to approve the 2013 Financial & Treasurer's Report, made by Ed Vest, support from Ron Erjavec. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL NEEDS FOR THE TOWN

Tony Tammaro, Town Board Chair, welcomed everyone and thanked Steve Shykes for agreeing to serve as moderator again this year.

Mr. Tammaro thanked and recognized the town board members, clerk and employees for all the work they do for the township.

Mr. Tammaro then explained the 2015 board recommended levy to the audience. Mr. Tammaro the board is recommending the following: General- \$95,000, Buildings & Grounds- \$53,000, Fire- \$66,000.00, Police- This is a two fold proposal. At last year's Annual Meeting, the people asked for a proposal for more police protection. The town board is recommending \$40,000, if police protection is maintained at the current 20 hours per week, or if the hours are increased to 40 hours per week the recommended amount is \$88,000, Recreation- \$20,000, Capital Equipment- \$30,000.00, Road & Bridge- \$280,000, Town Hall- \$10,000 for a total of \$594,000 or a 5.20% increase or with a 40 hour per week police- \$642,000, an increase of \$13.70% over 2014.

DESIGNATING POSTING PLACES

Moderator Shykes explained the present location of our posting places are as follows: 1) Fayal Town Hall, 2) West Long Lake Road, 3) East Long Lake Road, 4) Ely Lake Shortstop, 5) At Your Convenience, 6) Differding Point, 7) Fayal Website.

Motion to keep the posting places the same made by Ed Vest, support from DeLyle Pankratz. Motion carried unanimously.

SETTING TOWN BOARD SALARIES

Moderator Shykes then stated the next order of business is setting compensation for town board members. As of January 1, 20142 the Conus rate for mileage is 56 cents per mile. Currently, the salaries are as follows: Supervisor-\$3,828 per year, or \$319 per month, plus mileage and expenses as incurred, and Chair-\$4,224 per year, or \$352 per month, plus mileage and expenses.

Motion by Dave Hamalainen, support from Ejay Dawson to keep the salaries the same. Motion carried unanimously.

FIRE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS

Fire Chief Steve Shykes reported there were a total of 177 calls in 2013, of which 66 were EMS. Presently there are 25 firefighters, and the department is now fully staffed. The fire department had 810 hours of inhouse training and 280 hours of outside training. There are two Mesabi Community College fire instructors on the department. The simulcast agreement between the Fayal Fire Department and the Eveleth Fire Department is working out very well. The department received a ⁵⁰/50 matching grant from the MN DNR for \$5000, and is in the process of buying equipment with the funds. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

SUPERVISORS REPORTS

<u>Road & Bridge</u>- Jim Pernu reported April we hired Joe Zavodnik as our new equipment operator. Joe replaced Al Jurenic who accepted the foreman position after the retirement of Steve Verkovich. Graveling of St. Mary's Court and Scout Camp Lane, hauling approximately 700 yards of gravel.

A section of Golf Course Road was reclaimed, culverts changed and new blacktop installed. The intersection of Ely Lake Drive, Woodlawn East and Park Drive was redone by the county in conjunction with their reconditioning of Ely Lake Drive. Mr. Pernu also reported on other projects the road employees completed this past year, and planned projects for 2014. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Police—Heidi Coldagelli reported Harvey Thompson is our police officer and there were a total of 891 calls for the township this past year. That number includes medical emergencies, serving papers, animal calls, traffic stops, attempt to locate etc, and were not all crime related. Chief Thompson responded to 104 of the calls, which is 11% of the total calls which is exactly on par with the amount of time he works in one week. The township also hired the Mesabi Humane Society for six months on a part-time basis and they picked up numerous dogs and it greatly reduced the amount of animals running loose. Regarding the police levy for this year, Ms. Coldagelli stated a motion was passed at last years Annual Meeting to "look into effective and economical ways to provide increased law enforcement, which could include hiring or contracting out or pairing and sharing with other departments". Ms. Coldagelli stated she did some research and pairing and sharing with Eveleth would start out at \$150-200,000- that would be for full time coverage, and ballpark estimate it comes to about \$300 per residence. Less coverage, like one officer 40 hours per week would cost about \$75,000 per year. One other option is a COPS grant, but there is no funding for 2014 for that program. Ms. Coldagelli explained the two options for the police levy are \$40,000, which is an increase to allow for hiring the Mesabi Humane Society as well as some additional training for our current officer. The \$88,000 levy would be if we hired a full time officer and that would cover his salary and expenses.

DeLyle Pankratz asked if we are talking about a full time equivalency or a full time officer? Ms. Coldagelli replied the \$88,000 would be for us hiring a forty hour per week officer. For full time (24/7) coverage within the township that would be the \$150-200,000 per year—that would be Eveleth responding and patrolling.

Ed Vest asked if that includes a vehicle too? Ms. Coldagelli responded that we already have a vehicle. Mr. Vest stated it would have to be replaced at some point. Ms. Coldagelli agreed and stated that would be an additional expense.

Ejay Dawson asked if Ms. Coldagelli checked with St. Louis County, because there are other towns that contract with them? Ms. Coldagelli stated she did not check with them.

Mr. Dawson stated he checked with the city of Cook and they pay about \$60,000.

Dave Hamalainen asked when Harvey is not on duty, St. Louis County does cover us, and we don't get additional charges on that do we? Ms. Coldagelli stated that is correct, we do not, and we do not see any charges from the City of Eveleth if they respond either.

DeLyle Pankratz asked how many hours City of Eveleth and the St. Louis County Sheriff spends out here? Ms. Coldagelli stated she did not have a breakdown, but on the reports provided, you can see the calls Harvey is on and if backup was needed and who provided it.

Lee Branville stated the total number of calls, 891, seems to be flat and there does not seem to be any spike in the crime rate in Fayal Township over other years. Mr. Branville stated with the 787 calls the county takes care of and the 104 Harvey takes care of, we don't seem to be receiving complaints out here about lack of coverage—the way its working now, seems to be a good job. We had the dog issue, but that seems to have improved, people are watching out now for their dogs

Ejay Dawson asked if Harvey is accountable to anyone, or if he is his own boss with his own set of rules? Ms. Coldagelli stated that Harvey is accountable to the board and he has to obviously abide by the township's rules, and any other rules that govern him. He has to answer to us, just like all the other employees, and he has a contract.

DeLyle Pankratz asked who Harvey's designated township supervisor that supervises him? Ms. Coldagelli stated that is she. Mr. Pankratz asked if Ms. Coldagelli works out his schedule? Ms. Coldagelli stated he sets his own schedule and it is various hours throughout the week. Mr. Pankratz asked if the contract states that Ms. Coldagelli is to work with him on that? Ms. Coldagelli stated it does not. Clerk Sersha stated the contract says "random hours". Ms. Coldagelli stated that if it were brought to her attention that he is working odd hours that don't make sense, she would certainly bring that up to him. Ms. Coldagelli stated she sees him working all different days and hours, which is appropriate, based on the types of calls he gets. Ms. Coldagelli also stated Harvey is just a phone call away- if he is needed, we can call him and have him come in.

Joe Petrich asked who is going to make the decision as to whether we stay the same, or go with full-time police? Moderator Shykes explained the levy question will be two-fold, the people here tonight will decide whether or not we will go with a higher levy to provide for full time police, or with the lower levy and keep the same police coverage we have now. Mr. Petrich asked if we go full-time, does that automatically move Harvey into that position? Moderator Shykes explained that would be a union contract issue between him and the board.

<u>Buildings & Grounds-</u> Lee Branville reported the new building expansion to house the Public Utilities, Fire Hall, Road & Bridge equipment was completed this year. A fire-proof room was also added for records and document storage. Sidewalks and stairs were completed last fall. An information kiosk was built by the Range Technical College carpentry class for the Mesabi Trail. The ballfield was completed last fall. Emergency warning sirens were installed for the safety of our citizens in the event of severe weather or any disaster. One is located behind the town hall and one on the IRRRB property. Carbon monoxide detectors were also installed in the town hall and skating shack. We continue to do regular maintenance on the town's buildings and grounds to keep them in top notch shape for continued utilization for many years to come. A complete copy of this report is attached to these minutes.

<u>Recreation</u>- Mike Erjavec reported the ballfield is done and ready for playing this season. The rink had to be closed early this year because the hydrant broke. Jamie Lindseth was recently appointed as a representative of Fayal on the EFGSD Joint Rec Board.

<u>Public Utilities</u>- Mike Erjavec reported we have signed a 25 year contract with Gilbert for sewer. We currently have a contract for water with Eveleth, but have been negotiating with Gilbert for a possible water contract because we have customers on Differding Point that are serviced by Gilbert water. We have recently been notified by Gilbert that we will be receiving a 30% increase in our sewer rate, and we may have to raise the monthly rates by \$5-6.00. There may be some extension to the natural gas lines around Ely Lake this year, and possibly St. Mary's Lake in the future. A complete copy of this report is attached to these minutes.

Mr. Erjavec reported there have been numerous personal water lines frozen and a few sewer lines have also frozen this winter. Dave Hamalainen asked if Fayal is giving a rate to those whose lines have frozen and have to keep their water turned on.

Mr. Erjavec explained that we have to pay for our water by the gallon and our sewer by the gallon, so we are unable to give a rate to everyone who runs their water to avoid it freezing. Mr. Erjavec explained there was action taken at the last board meeting to give those who have had their water line freeze and have to keep their water turned on. Those people that notify us will be billed at the same rate of usage as last year at this time.

Ejay Dawson stated the City of Eveleth and City of Gilbert has a cost for their water- they don't get it for nothing-they have fixed costs. Mr. Erjavec disagreed and stated if they produce another 100,000 gallons of water, it doesn't cost them as much as the first million gallons—its costs them less to produce water than what they are selling it for. Mr. Erjavec stated we are breaking even, we are not making any money. Tony Tammaro added that we also have to pay to dispose of it. Mr. Erjavec stated we really should be metering the sewer, but those with private wells are against that so we are kind of stuck with a flat rate for everyone. There was more discussion on metering, not metering, how Eveleth/Gilbert/Virginia charge for sewer etc.

Dave Hamalainen asked if the board had done anything regarding an ordinance for utility delinquencies? Mr. Erjavec explained we were using a collection agency, but that didn't work out. We have more success by assessing delinquencies onto the property taxes. Eventually we get paid, or the homeowner loses their house. The delinquencies have remained flat, and it's the same people who are delinquent.

OTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE MEETING

Motion to set the Annual Meeting of 2015 on the second Tuesday in March at 7:00 PM, made by Steve Kniefel, support from Scott Smith. Motion carried unanimously.

Regarding the police and the levy, Ejay Dawson stated we have no way to check with the sheriff or other police and its going to be voted on tonight, so it's another year out before we can come back with a firm figure, like the City of Eveleth, City of Gilbert or the Sheriff's Department. Moderator Shykes agreed and stated that right now, the most economical proposal on the table is to increase the hours of the current situation-go from twenty hours per week to forty hours per week.

DeLyle Pankratz asked why does it have to be one person- why not a forty hour equivalent? Would it be appropriate to go with an equivalent of a forty hour per week position? Ms. Coldagelli explained that when she spoke to City of Eveleth, this was not just for sharing services with them, he was giving me price quotes, and it started pretty much at \$75,000 for a full time officer all the way up to \$200,000. So, if you were looking at two part time officers, you are probably looking at the exact same figure. Mr. Pankratz asked if this was open to negotiations? Ms. Coldagelli agreed it is, and stated she was just giving out general pricing.

Tracy Salin asked if the expenses would be more with two part-time versus one full-time? Ms. Coldagelli replied the full time position would be more expensive because you have to have health benefits. Clerk Sersha added that was the question that was asked last year, and the person making the motion specifically stated they wanted one full time officer, not two part-time positions. Mr. Pankratz stated he is not faulting anyone for looking at other options, but there is a concern about where we are at and how we are going to arrive at something and we need a little more direction from the members of the community. Clerk Sersha stated before the board can go ahead and expand the position they need to know if there are going to be funds available—the board cannot go ahead and make plans to hire someone if the funds are not there. Mr. Pankratz agreed.

Lee Branville stated we talked about raising the levy by \$52,000 and if you look at the coverage we are getting now, and the lack of any real problems we have out here, is there a need to have an additional officer and raise our expenses by \$52,000 when we could not spend that money. Mr. Branville stated that in his opinion, that is a lot of money for a lack of need at the present time—taxes are high enough. If we had a situation where things are rampant and we had a need for an additional officer, then we could say go ahead, but we are not in that place right now—we are doing fine out here with law enforcement as it is.

Mr. Pankratz agreed no one wants to raise taxes, but it should be an informed decision and an option, but there are many things we can do to cut taxes too.

Joe Petrich stated he was at an annual meeting here a couple of years ago and there was a large group here, the place was full, and they stated we don't need more police protection, and in fact it got to the point where we were going to say eliminate Harvey's job. Am I correct? Last year a couple come up with problems with dogs, and now all of a sudden we need more law enforcement—I don't see it, I agree with Lee- it's overkill.

Ejay Dawson asked if there was any way some supervisors and community members, between now and the next annual meeting, go out and get some firm figures, instead of this "about", we could check with the sheriff and the local communities. Moderator Shykes stated that is a good idea, but you have a tough time getting people to volunteer on commissions to spend time. Mr. Dawson stated he knows what Heidi said about Eveleth and he talked to Eveleth and got completely different figures.

Moderator Shykes stated that the people here could task the town board to solicit that, they can act upon your wishes, you can make a motion to have the town look into setting up a committee to investigate it, if that's the direction the group wants to go.

Tony Tammaro stated that's what we did this year from last year's annual meeting—the take was from the annual meeting exactly how we proposed it—we tried to get the best bang for the buck. We did check with Eveleth, we know that Gilbert charges Biwabik \$255,00 per year, and then we looked at a 20 hour versus a 40 hour, and that is why we came up with what we did. So, if they want to direct us to go out to St. Louis County or wherever, we can do that. Mr. Dawson stated you got directed last year and it wasn't done. Mr. Tammaro stated it was. Mr. Dawson again disagreed and stated you only checked with one, and there was nothing firm about it either. Mr. Dawson stated you did not check with the sheriff, Gilbert or anyone else. Clerk Sersha stated we checked with the sheriff several years ago. Mr. Dawson stated that is the problem, what are they now?

Dave Hamalainen stated that right now, it's not costing us anything to have St. Louis County come here when Harvey is not on—so why increase the levy? Lee Branville stated that is the second option for the levy, if you don't agree, vote no. Tony Tammaro stated you can still come back with a proposal for us to check with St. Louis County and Gilbert and we can come back with a firm proposal next year.

Moderator Shykes stated if there were more people willing to help the town board with the process, they may be more willing if people get involved, and he asked if anyone were willing to help?

DeLyle Pankratz asked when would it be the appropriate time to make the motion? Moderator Shykes stated the vote on the levy will come after the open floor discussion, but if there is anything more you would like to do with a working committee, now would be the time.

Ejay Dawson made a motion to get a committee formed consisting of citizens and board members to work with the board to obtain prices for law enforcement services. DeLyle Pankratz supported the motion. Moderator Shykes asked for discussion. Jim Pernu questioned who was going to be on this committee? Mr. Dawson stated that is up to the board. Mr. Pernu asked if they wanted two supervisors? Mr. Dawson answered yes, and some people from the township. Mr. Pernu stated we have a hard time, we can't even get anyone on the PUC, and asked if there is someone here who would volunteer? Mr. Dawson and Mr. Pankratz then volunteered for the committee as citizen members. Moderator Shykes asked if there were any more discussion. There being none, Moderator Shykes called for the question and asked for a show of hands. Mike Erjavec and Steve Kniefel voted no, everyone else voted yes. Motion carried.

Mr. Pankratz asked when this report due? Discussion. It was decided the report would be due by January 30, 2015, so the prices could be considered in the 2016 levy.

Moderator Shykes asked if there was any more business from the floor. There being none, Moderator Shykes stated we will now discuss the setting of the levy.

SETTING OF THE 2015 LEVY

Moderator Shykes explained there are two levy proposals to consider. The first one is for \$594,000, a 5.2% increase over last year, and includes funding for a twenty hour per week police officer. The second proposal is for \$642,000, a 13.7% increase over last year, and includes funding for a forty hour per week police officer.

Motion by Dave Hamalainen, support from Ejay Dawson to set the 2015 levy at \$594,000. Ed Vest asked why there was a \$4,000 increase in the police over last year? Heidi Coldagelli explained it is to cover costs for Mesabi Humane Society patrolling and additional training for the officer. There being no further discussion, Moderator Shykes called for the question. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Jamie Lindseth, support from Joe Petrich. Motion carried unanimously.

Moderator Shykes adjourned the Annual Meeting 2014 at 8:16 PM.

FAYAL TOWNSHIP 2013 ROAD & BRIDGE REPORT

In April of 2013 we hired Joe Zavodnik as our new equipment operator. He replaced Al Jurenic who accepted the foreman position. We graveled St. Marys court and Scout Camp Lane hauling approximately 700 yds. Of gravel. We had a section of of Golf Course Road reclaimed, culverts changed and new blacktop installed. We also had the intersection of Ely Lake Drive, Woodlawn East and Park Drive redone by the county in conjunction with their reconditioning of Ely Lake Drive. Throughout the course of the summer we cut a lot of vegetation on our right of ways along with brushing, dead trees and debris removal. A list of culverts that need replacing has been updated with work being done this summer. One of the more significant being a large arched culvert on Pleasant lane which is being contracted out.

We did some work on the ballfield including cutting out a warning track along the inside of the outfield fence, hauled some class five and black dirt, leveled the outfield and cut brush on the west side of the area beyond the right field. A small amount of grading was done on the north side of new garage along with extending the culvert that drains part of the hall parking lot. The rear tires on our 1987 backhoe were replaced.

Al and Joe's duties include equipment maintenance and some repairs; snowplowing and sanding; grading, graveling and dust control on dirt roads; drainage work; roadside mowing and tree removal; culvert steaming and replacement; shouldering, sweeping and patching blacktop roads; operating and maintaining a yardwaste site. Buildings and grounds, Recreation and Public Utilities are other departments they work for.

Work this summer other than culverts will include continued mowing of right of ways along with an assessment of our blacktop roads to determine which roads need to be addressed on a priority basis. We will also be graveling some dirt roads.

Buildings & Grounds Annual Report 2014- Lee Branville

Good evening, my name is Lee Branville. I am the Buildings & Grounds liaison. The public utilities/fire hall/road & bridge building addition was completed this year. The building houses our PUC equipment, Dales's truck, generators and all the PUC tools required to keep our sewer collection system running and our delivery systems maintained.

The fire department utilizes the center space for some of their equipment and the road and bridge department uses the west stall for their equipment. Access sidewalks and stairs were completed last fall. We also completed a document storage room

Just south of the hall the Mesabi Trail had an information kiosk built with Range Technical Carpentry students providing the labor. The township provided the slab which the kiosk sits on.

The ballfield was completed last fall. For all those that don't know where it is, it sits east of Woodlawn Drive and is accessed from Park. The sodding was completed and the fencing was installed. The diamond lines were completed and will be ready for games when the snow melts. The project was made possible by a number of grants and township contributions and the majority of labor was donated. Mark Forte spearheaded the project and did an awesome job.

Emergency warning signals were installed last fall for the safety of township citizens in the event of sever weather or any disaster that may occur. One is directly behind the town hall and the other is located at the IRRRB complex. These two locations take care of the lion's share of the Fayal population in terms of audible Emergency warning systems. The are tested on the first Wednesday of every month at 1:00 PM. This project was done in conjunction with sirens installed in Mt. Iron, Virginia and Eveleth.

Finally, it was noted that were lacking in carbon monoxide detectors in our public areas which was of concern as we utilize natural gas heating and have numerous vehicles running from time to time in the garage. Consequently we had detectors installed in all areas where employees and the public can be exposed to potential carbon monoxide hazards, including the skating shack.

We continue to do regular maintenance on all township buildings and grounds to keep them in top notch shape for continued utilization for many years to come.

Public Utilities Annual Report- Mike Erjavec

It has been an up and down year for the public utilities. Last year we were hoping to be able to contract with Eveleth for our wastewater treatment. It was just too expensive to build a line to Eveleth, but it did help get Gilbert to negotiate a better deal for Fayal. We now have a 25 year contract with Gilbert where they basically matched Eveleth's offer, with no need for any new infrastructure costs. We avoided a 40% increase in treatment costs for 2013.

Now, the bad news. We have recently been notified that we will be hit with a 30% increase from Gilbert, the same as their resident's increases according to our contract with them. This translates into a \$5 or \$6 increase per customer, monthly.

As far as water, we have been having some quality issues, especially in the summer months, so we have been exploring alternate sources. We currently have a contact with Eveleth, but are negotiating with Gilbert on a possible contract.

There is a possibility of some extension in natural gas lines, according to the gas company, mainly in the Ely Lake are, and possibly St. Mary's Lake in the future.
