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FAYAL TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING

MARCH 10, 2015

The Town of Fayal Annual Meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM by Clerk Judy Sersha. According to the sign-in sheet, 25 persons were in attendance. A list of those attending is attached to these minutes.

Clerk Sersha welcomed everyone to the Annual Meeting and introduced Tracy Salin as the new Deputy Clerk.

Clerk Sersha then called for nominations for moderator.

Motion by Lee Branville, support from Delyle Pankratz to nominate Steve Shykes as moderator. Clerk Sersha asked if there were any more nominations, there being none, Sersha called for the question. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Shykes welcomed the people to the Annual Meeting and asked everyone to stand to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF THE 2014 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2014 Annual Meeting, made by Lee Branville, support from Rich Sather. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL AND TREASURER'S REPORT

Moderator Shykes then called upon Clerk/Treasurer Sersha to report on the financial status of the town. The General fund began the year with \$398,461 and ended the year with a \$553,730 balance. The Road & Bridge Special Revenue fund began the year with \$246,320 and ended the year with a \$302,437 balance. The Town of Fayal Net Assets total as of December 31, 2014 was \$12,936,290.00. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Motion to approve the 2014 Financial & Treasurer's Report, made by Vicki Tuskan, support from Lee Branville. Motion carried unanimously.

FINANCIAL NEEDS FOR THE TOWN

Tony Tammaro, Town Board Chair, welcomed everyone and thanked Steve Shykes for agreeing to serve as moderator again this year.

Chairman Tammaro thanked and recognized the town board members, clerk and employees for all the work they do for the township. He also thanked Steve Shykes for agreeing to be moderator. He thanked outgoing supervisors Jim Pernu and Mike Erjavec for outstanding and dedicated service to Fayal Township.

Chairman Tammaro then explained the 2016 board recommended levy to the audience. Mr. Tammaro and the board is recommending the following: General- \$95,000, Buildings & Grounds- \$53,000, Fire- \$68,000, Police- \$40,000, Recreation- \$30,000, Capital Equipment- \$30,000, Road & Bridge- \$280,000, Town Hall- \$10,000 for a total of \$606,000 or a 2% increase over 2015. Jamie Lindseth asked why the Recreation budget was increased. Clerk/Treasurer Sersha stated the recreation budget was underfunded in the past couple years and the board is asking for more to finish the ball field.

DESIGNATING POSTING PLACES

Moderator Shykes explained the present location of our posting places are as follows: 1) Fayal Town Hall, 2) West Long Lake Road, 3) East Long Lake Road, 4) Ely Lake Shortstop, 5) At Your Convenience, 6) Differding Point, 7) Fayal Website. Dani Prout and Jamie Lindseth stated the 2015 minutes were not posted on Fayal website. Clerk Sersha will look into this and correct the issue.

Motion to keep the posting places the same made by Vicki Tuskan, support from Jamie Lindseth. Motion carried unanimously.

SETTING TOWN BOARD SALARIES

Moderator Shykes then stated the next order of business is setting compensation for town board members. As of January 1, 2015 the Conus rate for mileage is 57.5 cents per mile. Currently, the salaries are as follows: Supervisor- \$3,828 per year, or \$319 per month, plus mileage and expenses as incurred, and Chair- \$4,224 per year, or \$352 per month, plus mileage and expenses.

Motion by Mike Erjavec to increase Supervisor and Chairman salaries by \$25/month, support from Jerry Ulman . Motion carried unanimously.

FIRE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS

Fire Chief Steve Shykes reported there were a total of 127 calls in 2014 of which 34 were EMS. Presently there are 22 firefighters on the department. There are currently three openings on the fire department. There are 6 EMS first responders on the fire department. The fire department had 880 hours of in-house training and 275 hours of outside training. There is one Mesabi Community College fire instructor on the department. The agreement between the Fayal Fire Department and the Eveleth Fire Department for a simulcast page system is working very well.

In 2014 the fire department had an ISO review. The outcome was a reduction in ISO rating from a 7 to a 6. The fire department is seeking two FEMA grants as in past years. However funding cuts to this program have made it difficult to receive grants. The fire dept thanked everyone who attended the Fire Dept Relief Association spaghetti feed on March 8th. Mr Shykes thanked the community and staff for their past and continued support.

SUPERVISORS REPORTS

Road & Bridge- Supervisor Ochis reported in 2014, road work included applying approx. 1000 yards of gravel to Section 36, and approx. 400 yards to Long Lake Road West. After the strong wind storm in the summer of 2014, Joe Zavodnik and Al Jurenic, with help from the fire dept, spent approximately three weeks clearing trees from roads and removing all trees, branches, and debris. A Clam bucket was purchased after finding it very helpful during the storm clean up. The township also hired the county to help chip trees and brush. The brush pile was chipped and removed as it was exceptionally large. The road and bridge dept also mowed roads and right of ways during August. An assessment of blacktop roads was done to determine which roads need addressing based on priority. They added a Clemson leveler to the dam north of Cedar Island Drive to ensure water does not get too high. Al Jurenic and Joe Zavodnik replaced a 35 foot culvert on North Peary Road and another large culvert on Pleasant Lane. Equipment repairs were made to the grader. The township also purchased a pick up style sweeper for the loader and purchased culverts. Al and Joe performed equipment maintenance, repairs, snowplowing, sanding, grading, graveling, and dust control on dirt roads, drainage work, roadside mowing, tree removal, culvert seaming, repair to blacktop roads, and operating and maintaining the yard waste site. Tentative work for 2015 includes blacktopping Woodlawn Drive East, culvert replacement, street sign replacement, crack sealing, continued graveling, and vegetation removal along roadways. A complete report is attached to these minutes.

Planning Committee - Supervisor Coldagelli reported that the planning committee is working on the township's comprehensive plan with the Arrowhead Regional Development Commission regarding the future for Fayal with regards to housing, zoning, economic development, etc. In the next months there will be a meeting to finalize and accept the plan. Attendance and input are requested. The plan has not been updated since 2002 and needs to be updated as it is required for the IRRRB grant.

Police- Supervisor Coldagelli reported on the police department. There were 785 calls in 2014 of which 101 were responded to by the Fayal Police officer. The majority of calls were traffic stops, civil service papers, alarms, permits to carry, medical, and animal disturbance. At last years annual meeting a motion was made to assemble a committee of citizens and board members to explore pricing options for police force to find out what is the most cost effective way to provide law enforcement. Supervisor Coldagelli, Delyle Pankratz, Lee Brannville, and Ejay Dawson took part in the committee. A packet is attached to these minutes with the current expenses of the Police Dept and the law enforcement options and prices. There are quotes from Eveleth and the St. Louis County Sheriffs's Office. The board will discuss options.

Dani Larson asked if the board will look at making a decision on the police. Moderator Shykes said the people will make the budget decision tonight. Delyle Pankratz asked about Chief Thompson's contract ending this year. Clerk Sersha stated it's a standard union contract and if a labor agreement has not been reached by the expiration date, the employee works under the terms of the old contract. She has the contract if anyone wants to read it.

The annexation agreement contract with Gilbert was brought up which states Fayal may only contract with Gilbert police or St Louis County Sheriffs if additional law enforcement is needed. Supervisor Coldagelli stated she believes it is in place until 2023. Dani Larsen asked if the township can get out of the contract or amend it. Supervisor Coldagelli said the board and Gilbert would have to vote on and agree on an amendment or elimination of the contract. Mrs. Larson asked that the board ask Gilbert to amend the contract or get rid of it so that we can explore our options. Mrs. Larson said she thinks the option of contracting with Eveleth for policing would be the best and cheapest option.

Supervisor Coldagelli stated the board can discuss talking with Gilbert. She also asked Mrs. Larson where she sees the lower number for the Eveleth police on the report. Mrs. Larson stated she is looking at the Option B which states for \$40,000-45,000 we would get Eveleth to respond to all calls 24/7 which looks like the best deal. Supervisor Coldagelli clarified that our cost for the part-time Fayal police officer is and the Eveleth hourly rate is \$45 per hour. St Louis County responds at no cost at all and they patrol randomly. Mrs. Larson asked why we don't just have St Louis County patrol. Supervisor Coldagelli stated the St Louis County Sheriff patrols are very random and they will not enforce our ordinances, of which there are several. Mrs. Larson said she would like the board to look at seeing if Gilbert will do an amendment or eliminate the contract so that we can explore our options in the future. Supervisor Coldagelli stated the board can discuss speaking with Gilbert but the board will also look at the most cost effective option for police. Mrs. Larson stated the first step to looking at the most cost effective pricing would be to talk with Gilbert about an amendment so Fayal can explore other options. Chairman Tammaro stated the first step is to take the suggestion under advisement and file it.

Vicki Tuskan said she thought the point of the meeting with the citizens today is to make recommendations to the board and the board should follow the recommendations. Supervisor Coldagelli said the board did follow the recommendations from the citizens at last year's annual meeting and did go out and find quotes. Supervisor Coldagelli said the board will also look at the most cost effective means. She also brought up her concern that if Fayal contracted with St Louis County Sheriffs to patrol Fayal, they would no longer provide free patrolling as they do now. Mrs. Larson questioned the need for part-time Fayal police as we live in a low crime area.

Clerk Sersha stated there was an election in 2012 and the question was put on the ballot. The people mandated they wanted police protection. Mrs. Larson stated she did not understand the question as it was worded per legal ease. Clerk Sersha stated it was worded per state statute, as required. Chairman Tammaro suggested the people should ask the board to look at options with Gilbert. Mrs. Larson asked that a report be made to the citizens on what the board finds out regarding clarification on the contract with Gilbert and the possibility of amending it.

Vicki Tuskan asked for clarification on why Fayal entered into the contract with Gilbert. Clerk Sersha explained that around 1998, Fayal Township entered into an Orderly Annexation Agreement with Gilbert in order to protect funding for the sewer project that was being done. Fayal Township was to receive the funding for the project due to the fact that Fayal and Gilbert were doing a joint project and the funding was based on a point system. During that time, Eveleth tried to do a hostile annexation attempt. Had Eveleth been successful, Fayal would have lost the funding, and that was one of the reasons the contract with Gilbert was made. Fayal and Eveleth went before the MN Municipal Board and the annexation was not granted.

Clerk Sersha explained the annexation agreement with Gilbert will be voted on by both Fayal and Gilbert in 2020 in a special election. If both entities vote to combine, there will be a three year period for the orderly annexation of the two communities to take place. If one or the other, or both, communities votes it down, the agreement is over.

Chairman Tammaro said he feels the easiest way to deal with the Gilbert contract and look into options is to put this on the agenda for the next regular meeting to discuss and put a letter together to send to Gilbert. Chairman Tammaro asked Deputy Clerk Salin to add this item to the agenda for the next regular board meeting.

Moderator Shykes stated a motion is on the floor and called for a second for the motion. Clerk Sersha stated back the motion.

Motion made by Delyle Pankratz to have town board see if Gilbert will end the annexation agreement with Fayal Township regarding police. Vicki Tuskan seconded. Dani Larson amended the motion that the board contact Gilbert and report back to the public within three months. Motion carried.

Buildings & Grounds- Supervisor Branville reported the year 2014 was uneventful for buildings and grounds. A line item was added to the 2014 levy dedicated to Building which set aside money for future renovations. No major building projects are planned for the up coming year. Regular maintenance and repairs as needed will be done throughout the year to keep buildings and grounds in excellent condition for use by employees and citizens. A complete copy of this report is attached to these minutes.

Delyle Pankratz asked if there are plans to upgrade the office. Supervisor Branville stated no there is not but he thought maybe the Planning Committee might have some ideas. Mr Pankratz said maybe it could be looked at with the police issue because if Fayal doesn't have a police office, we could use that for office staff. Supervisor Branville stated yes we could consider that. Supervisor Coldagelli stated she will bring it up at the next planning meeting.

Nick Preiner asked about getting water up at the garages for cleaning vehicles and equipment. Supervisor Branville said he will look into it and get cost figures and look at feasibility to do so.

Recreation- Supervisor Branville reported the ball field was completed and used often last summer for Little League play. The tennis court perimeter fencing had repairs to the posts to correct tilting caused by frost. This year new striping will be added to the tennis court for pickle ball. A portable pickle ball net will be purchased for use on the tennis court so that it can be removed for regular tennis play. A complete copy of this report is attached to these minutes.

Public Utilities- Supervisor Sather reported on the public utilities. The natural gas line was extended around Ely Lake. Some homes were connected before the ground froze. The others will be connected in 2015.

Gilbert raised our sewer rates to the equivalent of 80 cents per resident on 1/1/15. We decided to absorb the last rate increase and would like to keep residential rates at \$57/month for the rest of the year unless something changes before then.

The current lift station system is 15 yrs old. There are many communication errors from lift stations back to the central computer at the Town Hall. The board is working on upgrading this system using funds from an IRRRB grant and some mining effects money as well as money already set aside in various accounts. This project should not impact resident's \$57.00 monthly bill.

Greg Buckley and Chris Erickson volunteered and joined the PUC commission in 2014. Both people have financial backgrounds. A complete copy of this report is attached to these minutes.

Dave Hamalainen asked about letters from Clerk Sersha regarding utility/sewer rate increases. When he compared one invoice from February of 2012 to June of 2014, he noticed the employee labor costs went up from \$7890 per month to \$10467 per month which is a \$2500 increase. He asked why its such a big increase. Clerk Sersha explained that due to GASB we are now required to book our post retirement funds for our employees up to age 65 and set aside the funding. Medical insurance premiums have also increased.

SETTING THE TIME FOR THE 2016 ANNUAL MEETING

Motion made by Vicky Tuskan, supported by Ron Erjavec to set 2016 Annual meeting on the second Tuesday in March at 7:00 PM. Motion carried unanimously.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE MEETING

Moderator Shykes called for New business from the public.

Mrs. Larson brought up the possibility of expunging the leash ordinance. Mrs. Larson stated she is upset that animal control patrols around her area frequently and will stop outside her yard and call her dogs. Mrs. Larson states she's outside watching and when she waves, they drive away. Mrs. Larson asked the board if they are seeing a decrease in animal at large complaints and if the township can put animal control on call to respond to specific reports of animals at large instead of performing regular patrols. Moderator Shykes asked Mrs. Larson if she has discussed this with any board members. She stated she has reported these concerns to board members but does not know if they have been brought forth. Mrs. Larson said she thinks the leash ordinance does not work, it punishes responsible dog owners, and there are still dogs at large every day. Mrs. Larson asked if the township can amend or rescind the ordinance or bring back a task force to discuss the ordinance again.

Moderator Shykes stated ordinances can only be amended by the board and suggested the board could put together a committee to discuss the leash ordinance again. Clerk Sersha agreed with Mr Shykes and stated that the ordinance was put in place because there was so many complaints about dogs running loose, biting people, messing up people's yards, etc. Clerk Sersha said there was a public input meeting held prior to a town board meeting. Mrs. Larson stated she was at the meeting and there was supposed to be a second meeting before the board voted but there never was a second meeting. Mrs. Larson asked if there is a way to request to have another public input meeting. Clerk Sersha said yes the town board can be asked to have another meeting.

Motion made by Dani Larson for the board to hold another public input meeting regarding the Leash ordinance. Seconded by Elaine Hammond. Eight in favor, ten opposed. Motion failed.

Supervisor Coldagelli stated that actually over the years the ordinance has been relaxed. It used to be that a dog at large could be destroyed. Mrs. Hammond stated the leash ordinance hasn't kept dogs from running through her yard, but punishes responsible dog owners. Mrs. Hammond said she thinks the township should just deal with a dog at large and not have ordinances punishing responsible dog owners. Mrs. Larson said animal control is calling dogs off her property. Clerk Sersha said animal control should not be doing that and that should be brought to the attention of animal control. Clerk Sersha stated she has noticed a difference in dogs walking loose. She also wanted to remind people that when walking on The Mesabi Trail, dogs must be on a leash because that's county property and their ordinance is to have dogs on leashes. Clerk Sersha commented that if a person is walking on the road with an unleashed dog, they would not be able to prevent the dog from running into traffic and getting hit. Mrs. Larson stated that should be the decision of the dog owner. She stated the ordinance doesn't allow for walking a dog on a shocker collar which she used to do. Mrs. Larson said the shocker collar was brought up at the public input meeting but not put into the ordinance so she would like to revisit the issue. Clerk Sersha stated the board can set up something. This can be an agenda item at the next board meeting and will be posted. Mrs. Larson asked when how far in advance of the meeting will the notice be posted. Clerk Sersha stated it will be posted two weeks in advance.

Keith Nelson suggested the board consider the diversity of the township when discussing and amending the leash ordinance and if making amendments, they could consider creating zones within the township. In response to request for clarification of the ordinance, Clerk Sersha stated about two years ago, the ordinance was amended to state that if a dog is off your property it should be on a leash. Chairman Tammaro requested the public and board set up the input meeting to discuss these issues. Delyle Pankratz suggested that the problem is more with how animal control patrols than the ordinance itself. Mr. Pankratz suggested perhaps the board speak with animal control regarding their patrolling guidelines. Moderator Shykes called for the motion.

Motion made by Dani Larson for the board to clarify with animal control about proper guidelines for handling calls in Fayal and make patrol areas more random. Seconded by Elaine Hammond. All in favor. Motion carried.

Vicki Tuskan asked about the gas line extending to West Long Lake Drive and what happened to petition? Mrs. Tuskan said she tried to contact someone from the letter she received but got no response. Chairman Tammaro stated the person in charge of that project lost her assistants, but the plan is still available. Mr. Tammaro suggested Mrs. Tuskan should check with Diane Dickson about this.

Pat Brascugli brought up speeding down her road which is Airport Drive N. She believes the speeding is the result of two businesses down the road past her. Mrs. Brascugli asked to know when this road became a township road and if the township could place a speed limit sign, speed bump or flashing speed sign on her road to slow drivers down. She stated her property marker was removed and would like it replaced so that she won't have to pay to have her property surveyed.

Mrs. Brascugli made a recommendation that Fayal meetings be taped. If not if the minutes could be published in the Mesabi Daily News.

Vicki Tuskan made a motion for the board to let Pat Brascugli know and post in minutes when Airport Drive N. became a township road. Motion failed for lack of a second motion.

Moderator Shykes asked for motions for these issues stated by Mrs. Brascugli. Chairman Tammaro stated a motion is not needed as they can be discussed at the next meeting. Clerk Sersha said Mrs. Brascugli can come in and talk with her anytime and any speeding problems can be discussed with law enforcement.

Clerk Sersha asked that everyone remember to sign the sign in sheet for the meeting.

SETTING OF THE 2016 LEVY

Moderator Shykes asked for a motion to set the levy for the year 2016. Motion made by Jerry Ulman to set the levy at 606,000, a 2% increase, with support by Mike Erjavec. Motion carried.



 - 1 Other
2. There are 22 firefighters on the department. There two firefighter retirements and one firefighter moved out of the area. At this time there are three openings on the fire department.
3. There are 6 EMS first responders on the fire department.
4. In 2014 the fire department had 880 hours of in house training and 275 hours of outside training. The fire department has 1 Mesabi Community College fire instructors on the department.
5. The agreement between The Fayal Fire Department and The Eveleth Fire Department for a simulcast page system is working very well.

FAYAL TOWNSHIP 2014 ROAD AND BRIDGE REPORT

In 2014, road work included applying approximately 1000 yards of gravel to Section 36, and approximately 400 yards to Long Lake Road West.

We were hit with a pretty big wind storm that knocked over a lot of trees in the township. Al was out with an emergency appendectomy, therefor Joe and Dale were initially on there own to take care of liftstations and road clearing. Members from the fire department were called to help Joe with road clearing and tree removal, and assisted with chainsaws, operating the backhoe, loader, and dump trucks as necessary. To get everything totally cleaned up off of all the roads took approximately 3 weeks. We rented a clam bucket from Ziegler Cat, which allowed for easy removal and loading of brush and trees. This bucket was found very useful, so the township purchased it. We also hired the county to help chip trees and brush. We had our brush pile chipped and removed, seeing as this year it was exceptionally large and would take quite a long time to burn.

We also mowed roads throughout the month of August.

A new Clemson leveler was added to the dam north of Cedar Island Drive to ensure that the water level does not get too high.

Al and Joe replaced a 35' culvert on North Peary Road. A large culvert on Pleasant Lane was replaced in September.

Equipment repairs included grader repairs on the air system, engine, and hydraulic system.

The township also purchased a new pick-up style sweeper for the loader, and purchased culverts.

Al and Joe's duties include equipment maintenance and some repairs, snowplowing and sanding, grading, graveling and dust control on dirt roads, drainage work, roadside mowing and tree removal; culvert steaming and replacement, shouldering, sweeping and patching blacktop roads, and operating and maintaining a yardwaste site. Buildings and grounds, Recreation and Public Utilities are other departments they work for.

Work this summer other than culverts included continued mowing of right of ways along with an assessment of our blacktop roads to determine which roads need to be addressed on a priority basis.

Tentative work for 2015 includes blacktopping Woodlawn East, culvert replacement, street sign replacement, cracksealing, continued graveling, and vegetation removal along roadways.

Buildings and Grounds Report

My name is Lee Branville and I am the Liaison for Building and Grounds. This past year was somewhat uneventful compared to the prior year when the township completed the PUC/Road and Bridge/Fire Department storage building.

The ball field was completed and used often last summer for Little League play.

The tennis court perimeter fencing required repairs as the frost over the years caused the posts to tilt and in turn the gates were becoming nonfunctional. This year new striping is being installed to utilize one of the courts for Pickleball. A portable Pickleball net is also being purchased so that it can be moved off court for people to play tennis.

No major building projects are planned for the upcoming year. The board added a line item to the Levy dedicated to the Building which is to set aside money for future renovations.

PUC Report March 10, 2015

Natural gas: The line was extended around Ely Lake. Some houses were connected before the ground froze; the others will happen in 2015.

Sewer

Gilbert raised our rates the equivalent of 80 cents per resident on 1/1/15. We decided to absorb the last rate increase and would like to keep residential rates at \$57/month for the rest of the year, unless something changes before then.

Many lift stations are having communication failures back to the central computer in Town Hall. The communication system is 15 years old and needs to be upgraded. Part of the cost will be paid by an IRRRB grant and probably some "Mining Effects" money. The rest will probably come from money already set aside in various accounts. This project should not impact your \$57 monthly bill.

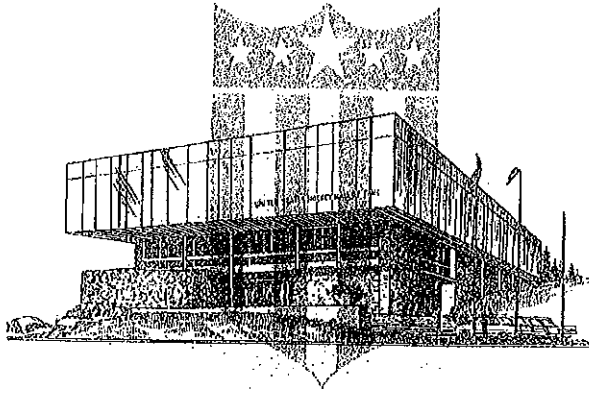

Police Dept Report:

Welcome everyone I am Heidi Coldagelli and I am the liaison for the Police Department, Fire Department, Planning Committee, Finance Committee, and the Blight Officer. First I will mention that as the Planning Liaison I am currently working on the Township's Comprehensive Plan with a committee and the Arrowhead Regional Development Commission. Basically it is what we would like to see in Fayal's future regarding things such as housing, zoning, economic development, preservation, etc. In the next coming months we will be having a public meeting regarding finalizing and accepting the plan and I would welcome and encourage you all to attend that meeting. If anyone has any input or would like to get some further information feel free to contact me. The plan is a good thing for any township or city to have established but is also now a requirement for IRRRB Grant applications.

In regards to our Police Department, Fayal had a total of 785 calls of which 101 of those calls were responded to by our officer. The majority of the total calls were traffic stops, civil paper service, permits to carry, medical, alarms, and animal disturbances. We are fortunate that we live in a community that our citizens can feel safe and that we have minimal amounts of criminal activity. I commend Chief Thompson for a job well done in 2014 and appreciate what he continues to do for our township. At last year's annual meeting a motion was made to create a committee of both citizens and board members to obtain prices for law enforcement services and options. I thank those involved that volunteered their time to make sure that the township is making the most informed decision regarding its citizens' safety while taking into account costs and benefits and ensuring that we are providing the most cost effective means.

Dear Supervisor Branville:

I understand that the Town of Fayal might have an interest in the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office providing law enforcement services for your township. If that is the case, I envision an arrangement similar to the model used by Canosia and Rice Lake Townships.

With input from the township, a budget and schedule are established and deputies sign up to fill these shifts. It is important that the town board provide input as to how we concentrate our patrol efforts. For example: enforcement of traffic laws during the morning and evening commute hours; business and residence checks; or, in some instances, select ordinance enforcement. The hours that are worked are billed monthly at \$60.00 per hour. This rate covers the deputy's overtime rate (salary and benefits) as well as the wear and tear and gas for the squad car. The deputies that work these shifts would be supervised by Supervising Deputy Jon Skelton of the Virginia Duty Station.

If there is further interest or questions regarding the service we can provide, please feel free to contact Supervising Deputy Skelton at 749-7167, or me at 726-2341. We would also be available to appear at a Town Board meeting if requested.
