NEW BUSINESS

The board studied the Gulf Course Road improvements proposal provided by SEH Engineer Brad Reifsteck.

Motion to accept the proposal from SEH for the Golf Course Road improvements, in an amount not to exceed \$10,093.00, made by Vice-Chair Tammaro, support from Supervisor Pernu. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to accept the proposal in the amount of \$6,455.00 from SEH for the Solar Panel Improvement Project, made by Vice-Chair Tammaro, support from Supervisor Erjavec. Supervisor Branville questioned what the ongoing maintenance costs would be for the solar panel? Vice-Chair Tammaro stated he did not know the answer, but would find out for the next meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to award the Solar Panel Improvement Project to Hometown Electric in the amount of \$105,208.00, made by Supervisor Erjavec, support from Supervisor Pernu. Supervisor Branville questioned if there was more than one bid? Vice-Chair Tammaro stated there was another quote from Conservation Technologies in the amount of \$106,375.00. Motion carried unanimously.

The letter of interest from Benchmark Engineers was placed on file.

Short discussion on whether or not to stay in the E-F Joint Cable TV Commission.

Motion to stay in the E-F Joint Cable TV Commission, made by Supervisor Branville, support from Supervisor Pernu. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion on the DNR land auction to be held December 7, 2011. The auction sale includes a 26.5 acre parcel along St. Mary's Lake, minimum bid is \$655,785.00. Clerk Sersha reported she called Kate Gale of the DNR to inform her there is an easement for sewer on this property, and that each subdivision of land on this parcel is subject to a \$7,000 sewer access charge. This was not noted on the sale bill or internet site.
