Letter from Kniefel to Aluni re: the 60 day notice on the new rates from Gilbert. Old business.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Letter from Kniefel to Aluni re: new rates from the City of Gilbert. Lengthy discussion, Campbell would like to ask SEH for an opinion. PUC feels we are a bulk customer, and should not have to pay for the City of Gilbert's lines, depreciation, or any other costs over the actual cost of water plus a profit. Erjavec's calculations show Gilbert's rates are going up 22% and Fayal's will go up 45%. The City shows they have a 54% water loss.

- Motion by Erjayec to make an offer to Gilbert for \$3.75 per 1,000 gallons for water.

Campbell would like more time to go over the real costs of the water and the sewer.

Supervisor Tammaro states years ago the Fire Dept, Rec. Dept, and Building Dept. paid the water company a yearly fee for water used. PUC would also like to see the general fund pay for the water line depreciation, as it is for fire protection.

- Motion by Bertucci to send a letter to the Town board requesting an annual charge be transferred into the water company in the amount of \$600 per dept Fire Dept, Recreation Dept, and Building. Second by Damberg.
