Chris has reviewed the agreement and it does not allow for a debt service charge counting our customers, we are one bulk customer.

Sewer Line Cleaning- Great Lakes Pipe Service, Inc. is scheduled to start cleaning section #1 October 15<sup>th</sup> they were going to wait for it to dry up, and it has been raining now. They have to do the restoration as part of the contract.

4 M Fund- Chris will contact Heidi the interest rates just went up.

Gilbert Waterline to Eveleth- Councilman Pontinen met with Tony and said they are not going to use Eveleth water, they are going to do a large water plant project instead.

The motion by PUC to change the Standby charges was not brought forward. Supervisor Pat Ziegler does not agree with this and would not bring it forward. Clerk Coldagelli brought it forward and the Vice Chairman tabled it.

 Motion by Cal Turner to ask for another representative if Pat Ziegler refuses to bring our recommendations forward. He is an elected official, he does not have to agree with it, but it is his duty to bring it forward. Second by Greg Buckley. Discussion- Chris would like to give him another chance. If Pat chooses not to bring our information to the Board, then we would ask for another representative.
