# **CORRESPONDENCE**

MDH final report No Coliform bacteria were detected. 4-27-07.

Bill register summary, billed \$58,261 for May 07.

Delinquency report \$20,521.76 is past due.

Lengthy discussion about options for dealing with past due accounts. Maybe give a discount for paying ahead to generate revenue to make up for unpaid. Then, raise the rate for the late bills. Look into offering auto deduct, meter reading could go in the memo or have them do a quarterly or yearly reading.

- Motion by Bertucci to anyone over \$500 past due put it in small claims court. Second by Erjavec for the discussion. Campbell wants to know who is going to go to court? \$150 is the filing fee. Supervisor Branville would like to bring several ideas to the Town Board for direction.

# WATER

Three 10" water line valves are not functioning. Not sure what it will cost, J & S will come and check out the damage when the town has the valves exposed. Permission granted to do what is necessary to make the repair.

- Motion by Erjavec to have Dale use his judgment looking for bids for the annual lift stations maintenance, second by Campbell. Motion carried unanimously.
- Motion by Damberg to have Dale use his judgement with the waterline valves repair or replace what is needed, second by Troutwine. Motion carried unanimously.

Emergency lighting has been installed in the barn.

Hometown is supposed to be bringing a quote for a generator that will run the Township including the garage doors, the portable generators will not run the Town Hall.

# **TREASURER**

Campbell reports on the Fayal Water Company the cash balance is \$26,374. It does appear to be falling behind. The Fayal Sewer Company cash balance is \$43,700 \*payment on 3<sup>rd</sup> loan due from FSC August 07 \$39,760. Note we have been paying Gilbert at the old rate. (see attached report)
