CORRESPONDENCE

<u>Delinquency Reports</u> - As of 9-26-22 \$12,920.98. Amount is about the same as last month. Only five residents will be certified to taxes, all others have paid or almost paid off their delinquent amounts. Township collects delinquent utility payments by either talking with residents and collecting money or certifying amounts owed to the resident's property taxes, the Township has always received payment from the St. Louis County for the delinquent utility bills.

<u>September Water/Wastewater Report</u> - Senior Waste Water Operator Rick Beiganek is working with a camera crew to inspect the lift stations and sewer lines. September and into October has been busy with routine maintenance and preparation for winter.

<u>St. Louis County Short Term Rental</u> - Currently this is not a significant issue for Fayal Township and at this time the PUC has no comments.
