Aquatic Invasive Species Program- Keith Nelson confirmed that North St. Louis County Soil and Water Conservation District was awarded a grant from St. Louis County. There were a few funds leftover from the previous year and the Town is interested in having a mailing sent to the residents regarding aquatic invasive species.

Comprehensive Plan Review- Reviewed last meeting.

Picnic Shelter at Playground- Materials for the small garage have been purchased and the project is nearly wrapped up. Coldagelli will apply for an Eveleth Community Foundation Grant for the purchase of some picnic tables and benches at a cost of \$5,000.00.

Grant Funding Opportunities- Coldagelli will apply for a grant with the Eveleth Community Foundation. The Town Board discussed lighting funding for the ballfield and seeking in kind services. Discussion regarding MN Power grants. Discussion regarding the waterline running down to the ballfield. Coldagelli did speak with Chairman Tammaro and the interest was to run the waterline at this time to the one location.
