During the month of January, 2024 the Fayal Fire Department Staff trained for 8 hours on Annual Requirements of Blood Borne Pathogens, Right to Know, Haz Mat Awareness and Fire Ground Operations/Tactics.

Annual Firefighter Physical Assessments were performed and documented by Fairview HealthCare.

Lieutenant Widmer and Staff completed minor cosmetic repairs within FFD Station #1 and Station #2. LT. Widmer also placed the new SCBA Cylinders and Batteries into service.

Captain Sklors and Engineers rolled out a new electronic records system for Vehicle Fleet Maintenance and performed Monthly Apparatus Checks. Small engine repairs and maintenance were performed as well along with upgrades to the Station #1 Air System.
