<u>Water/Wastewater Reports</u> – Comments made on more problems with bases. Town Board Chairman Tammaro commented we did buy some valves. Hiti reported for approx. \$8800.00.

Mediacom Communications Corporation – Chairman Vest comments it appears to be going up.

OLD BUSINESS

St. Mary's Lake Development - Chairman Vest commented that he hasn't heard anything on this.

EPA Lead and Copper Survey – We have about 46 residents yet to return their surveys.

<u>Sewer Camera and Locator</u> – The Board does want Clerk Coldagelli to re-apply for the OSHA safety grant. <u>Smith Property</u> – Chairman Vest updated us that the property has been re-zoned.

City of Eveleth Water Rate Changes - The increased rates will be effective in Fayal's March billing.

Fayal PUC Year End Balance – Beginning Balance \$2,185.95, Expenditures \$11,353.09, Ending Balance \$2,262.17

Fayal Water Company- beginning balance was \$32,516.67. Revenues were \$6,373.38 and expenditures were \$4,110.05. Ending cash balance was \$32,537.91.

Fayal Sewer Company- beginning balance was \$171,308.17. Revenues were \$81,378.06 and expenditures were \$24,126.19. Ending cash balance was \$228,562.93. Depreciation 4M was \$199,934.69 and PUC Truck Depreciation 4M was \$37,075.78.

PUC- beginning balance was \$2,262.17. Revenues were \$0 and expenditures were \$31.09 for an ending cash balance of \$2,231.08.

Commissioner Erickson commented that the financials cashflow are in a positive direction.
