CORRESPONDENCE

<u>Delinquency Report</u> — O'Brien not pleased with how long it is this month, Hiti to make phone calls at the end of the month to try and collect some of this money owed. Jackson suggested how easy it is to pay your utility bill, as far as bill pay, credit card or drop your payment in the bill slot.

May Water/Wastewater Report - Vest asked what is a RONK? Commissioner Erjavec explained it.

OLD BUSINESS

- a. <u>Sewer Rate Change</u> Tabled.
- b. <u>Pat Ziegler Sewer line</u> Vest commented that the 45 days have passed, have we heard anything? Is he going to unhook the additional line? Can the SAC payment be transferred from the garage building to house building? Table this discussion until we get more information on what is being done.
- c. <u>Sump Pump Letter</u>- Discussion was made that only 111 sump pump surveys have been returned. Chairman O'Brien informed the committee that we could charge an extra \$10.00 a month until we/they send in their surveys and pictures for verification. Discussion made to give another 30 days and then discuss how to proceed.

NEW BUSINESS

- **a.** Promissory note/Amortization schedule Commissioner Erickson commented on the Fire Dept. interest rate, so as to use the same rate for the promissory note.
 - Motion to recommend to the Town Board that Fayal charges the 4.5% interest on the note, made by Commissioner O'Brien and supported by Commissioner Erickson. Motion carried unanimously.
- **b. Hump in ditch** Vest commented there is a hump in the ditch on St Mary's Ct, made by the gas company which could cause drainage issues. This should be checked out.
